DECISION ON APPEAL

In the matter of the campaign finance penalty appeal
by Central Virginia Young Democrats (PP-26-00007)
May 28, 2026

FACTS

The above-named petitioner had a campaign finance report due on April 15, 2026, at 11 :59:59 PM. Petitioner submitted the report on March 10, 2026, at 1 :01 PM. A \$100 civil penalty for failure to file the required report was issued by ELECT on May 8, 2026.

Pursuant to § 24.2-953.6 of the Code of Virginia (the Code), petitioner submitted a *Petition to Appeal Campaign Finance Penalty* to the State Board of Elections (SBE) on May 9, 2026. Petitioner sought relief in the form of forgiveness of the assessed penalty. Petitioner's basis for appeal was that circumstances made filing the required reports or requesting an extension by the deadline impracticable. Petitioner stated that good cause existed to provide relief due to lack of knowledge of a report being due prior to the Statement of Organization submission.

DECISION

The SBE heard the appeal on May 28, 2026. Pursuant to § 24.2-953.6 of the Code, the SBE granted relief as requested by the petitioner for ability to demonstrate good cause.

RATIONALE

In finding that the petitioner demonstrated good cause, the SBE noted that the committee was not legally obligated to file campaign finance reports per § 24.2-950.1, given they spent/received less than \$15,000 in a calendar year.
